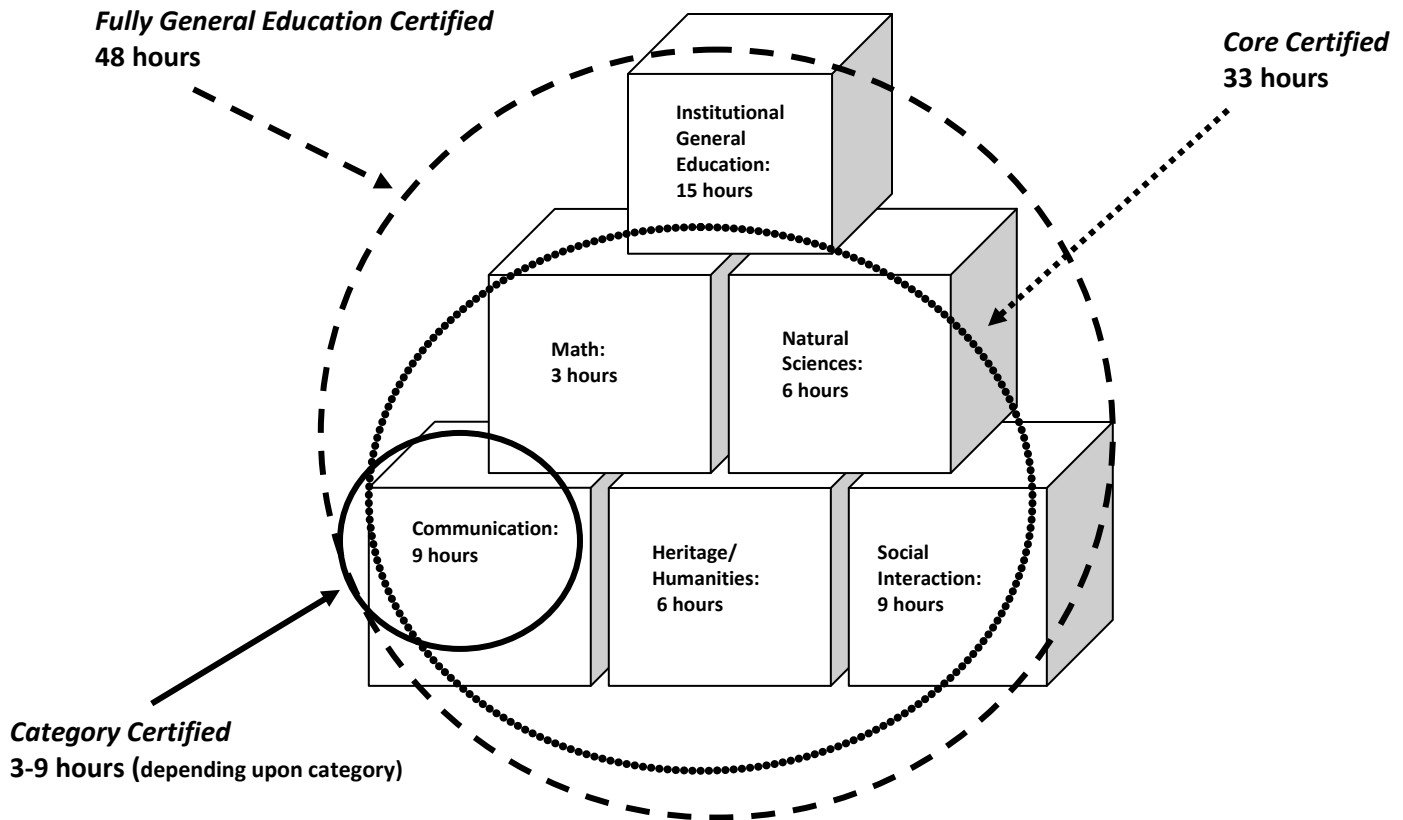

The “Building Blocks” for General Education Transfer *Guaranteed transfer to any Kentucky 4-year public institution*



There are three levels of general education certification within the General Education Transfer Policy. Each level is based on the number and category of courses taken. Students can complete general education courses in categories or “blocks”, as a core component and as a complete general education program of 48 hours. Each level of certification is identified below:

Category Certified —————

Students in good academic standing that have completed some but not all of the five categories in the 33-hour Core Component will be “**Category Certified**” for purposes of transfer. Hours will vary in each category. The five categories are: Communications (ENG101, ENG102 and an oral communications course); Heritage & Humanities; Mathematics; Science; and Social Interaction.

Core Certified

Students in good academic standing who have completed all of the categories in the “core” – the core component – for a total of 33 hours will be “**Core Certified**” for purposes of transfer. Individuals in this category must fulfill the remaining gen. ed. requirements of the receiving institution that have not been satisfied through the core component.

Fully General Education Certified - - - - -

Students in good academic standing who have completed a general education program of 48 semester hours which includes the 33 hour core and all additional institution-specific general education courses will be “**Fully General Education Certified**” for purposes of transfer. Students have completed everything but 12 hours of electives.
