

Part II: How to Use Your Reading Test Scores 2008-2009

Students can use Compass reading scores to determine what, if any, reading course is needed. Students who place in any reading level must enroll in the reading class during the first semester and continue through the reading sequence until it is completed OR until a COMPASS re-test indicates reading proficiency for college entry level courses. For example, if you take RDG 020 during the fall semester, you must either take RDG 030 during the spring semester or re-test on the Compass, making the appropriate placement score listed below in order to bypass RDG 030.

Students who place in RDG 030 or RDG 020 may take only the courses listed below, in addition to English and math courses (as determined by test scores; see the other side of this sheet for more information). Please consult your advisor to use your Asset or SAT scores for course placement. These courses are based on availability.
